USA'S Eugenie Scott, described in the journal *Science*, vol 295, p2009 15 March 2002 as "a tireless battler against the forces of darkness on the evolution front" (that evolution speak for Creation Research) has received the 2002 Public Service award from the National Science Board (of the USA).
